Update on School Opening Status

Following the government announcement this week about the potential of primary schools re-opening on 1st June 2020, we felt it essential that we write to all parents.

The government has stated, any re-opening of schools will be conducted in a phased manner, with Year R, 1 and Year 6 possibly being the first to return after half term. It was also mentioned that students in secondary schools, who are scheduled to be taking exams next year, will return at some point prior to the summer holiday. However no dates have been provided at this time.

As a consequence of the announcement, and until we receive further clarification, we will continue to provide work for all secondary students virtually and welfare checks will be conducted daily, as they have been over the last two months.

We assume FSM vouchers will continue to be issued for students who are at home and we will let you know if and when any changes occur.

We realise this has been a very challenging time for all families and please rest assured we will continue to support in any way required.
