Labour Market Information



Labour Market Information (LMI) is an important tool to help us identify which jobs are on the increase and where we identify jobs that will pay us the best wage!

The information on the tables below will provide you with details of the local picture in the London Borough of Bromley.

This information is based on statistics from 2016 and will be updated on a regular basis.

It is estimated that jobs in London will grow from 2016 at an annual average rate of 0.78 per cent a year, equivalent to 49,000 jobs, to reach 6.907 million in 2041.

Jobs in the professional, real estate, scientific and technical sector are expected to grow strongly, accounting for over a third of the total increase expected in London to 2041. Strong employment growth is also expected in the administrative and support services, accommodation and food services, information and communications sectors, education and health sectors. The six sectors account for nearly three fifths of the expected total London increase in jobs to 2041.

The annual growth rate in Bromley is almost identical with that for London as a whole at 0.77 per cent a year.
